

Music Video Project

Using a song of your choice, create a music video that communicates visually what the song means to you. This is your chance to really be expressive.

- Your video must be at least 1 ½ minutes long – it may be longer but it is not as easy as it seems.
- You may work alone or with a partner.
- You may use as many others in the video as you need – students or non-students. It may end up on my web page so make sure you have their permission.
- You can use an original song that you wrote, a friend's band, a song of iTunes. It has to be SCHOOL APPROPRIATE. No references to drugs, violence, or sex.
- The footage must be your own, except for still photos from the internet, short clips from a feature film (under 5 continuous seconds) or newsreel footage. No footage from another music video may be used.
- You can use family home movies, your own animation, puppets, artwork – be creative.
- You may lip-sync for some of it but the majority should be visuals that tell your story.
